Description

The main objectives of the plan were to determine the physical expansion requirements for increasing enrollment beyond 1000 students, to determine the future land uses for existing open space, and to define a strategy to beautify the campus by preserving and enhancing its historic buildings and park-like setting. After completing a detailed inventory and analysis of the existing campus, it was determined that the college would be greatly enhanced by centralizing its new academic buildings around the existing Rocky Green. Other design elements that were incorporated into the Master Plan included a new soccer field, developing several open spaces into "greens," a streetscape program, new vehicular entries into campus, a building and grounds renovation program, land for private partnership facilities, and a variety of new buildings to accommodate future growth.

The plan also included an implementation strategy that specifically addressed phasing, costs and priorities, thereby providing a framework for future expansion that can be implemented as growth occurs. This allows the final Master Plan document to provide a common sense, flexible approach to Rocky Mountain College's growth into the 21st century.



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
